The fund is specifically designated for improvements consistent with the "Davis Islands Community Plan - A Shared Vision of Our Future."

The Projects

Our first project was helping to fund restoration of historic Roy Jenkins Pool.

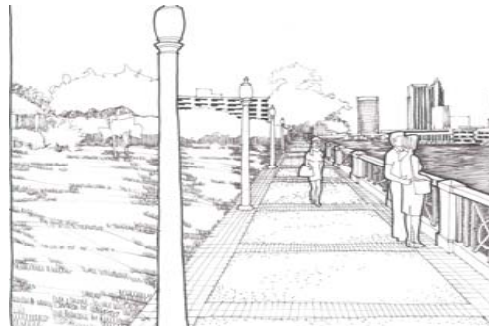
Going forward, money raised will be spent on the following capital improvement projects, in priority order:

- WALKWAY/TRAIL: Complete the Seddon Channel water front walkway & paved trail from Tampa General Hospital to Seaplane Basin Park beach - Preliminary estimate \$2 million
- COMMUNITY/RECREATION CENTER: Build a community/recreation center within the Tampa Parks & Recreation property on Columbia Drive - Preliminary estimate \$2 million

The Davis Islands Civic Association Board of Directors recommends projects and priorities, which are subject to change over time as projects are completed.
